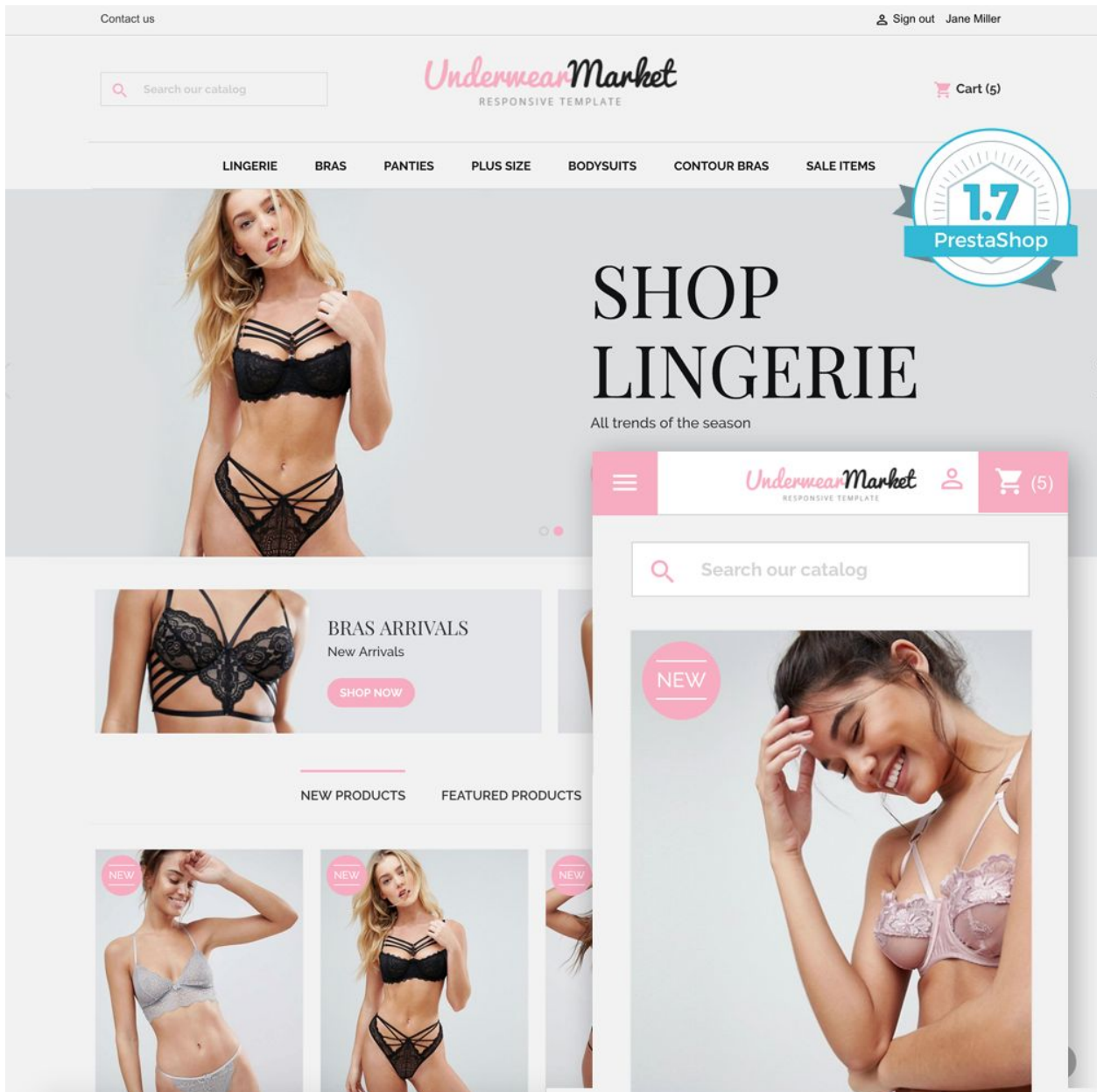


The theme is fully responsive and perfectly works both on desktop and mobile devices under any operating system.

1. PrestaShop 1.7 Theme Installation

In order to install a new theme from Admin Panel, please follow these steps.

Go to **Design** → **Themes & Logo** and press **Add New Theme** button.

Upload Zip of the theme in the next window.

2. Theme Compilation

In order to compile and change style of theme you need to install **Webpack** module bundler into your development environment.

2.1 Webpack installation

Webpack installation expect that you have installed node.js on your machine. If it has not been installed yet, install node.js <https://nodejs.org/en/>

After node.js has been installed, install webpack into theme `_dev` folder:

-npm install webpack

After webpack has been installed, run command in order to install theme configuration:

-npm install

And now you are able to change styles, run command:

-npm run watch

Illustration below describes the process of theme compiling.

PRESTASHOP 1.7 CLASSIC THEME COMPILING WITH WEBPACK

Install Webpack into `_dev` folder:

```
npm install webpack
```

Be sure `package.json` file added to `_dev` folder



`package.json`
declares
dependencies
to install

Install dependencies from `package.json`:

```
npm install
```

AND FINALLY

Rebuild `assets` every time you change files:

```
npm run watch
```

3. Theme Styles

3.1 Theme variables

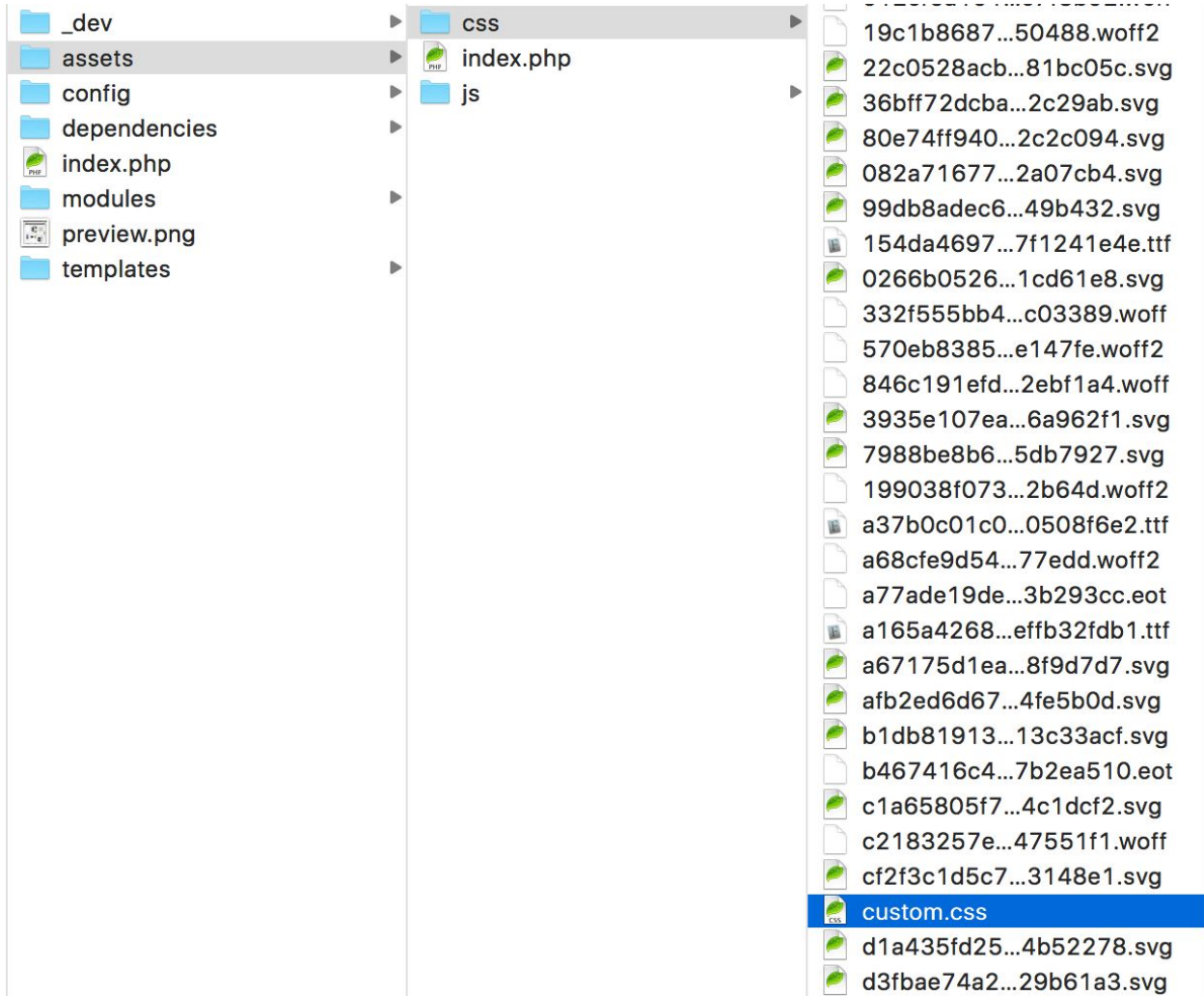
You are able to change theme styles in `_dev/css` theme folder. `_dev/css/partials` folder contains `_variables.scss` file that contains theme variables such as **brand color**, **background color**, **text color**, **breakpoints** and others.

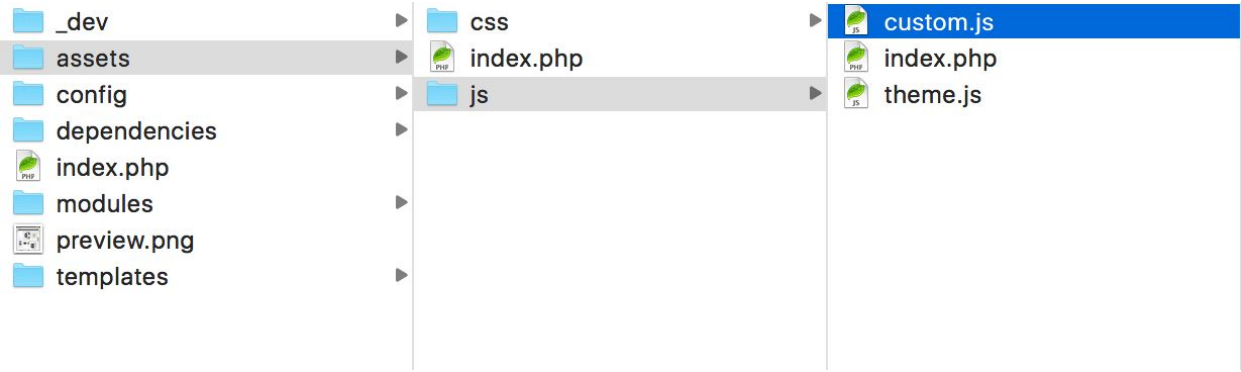

Also you are able to change js files in `_dev/js` folder.

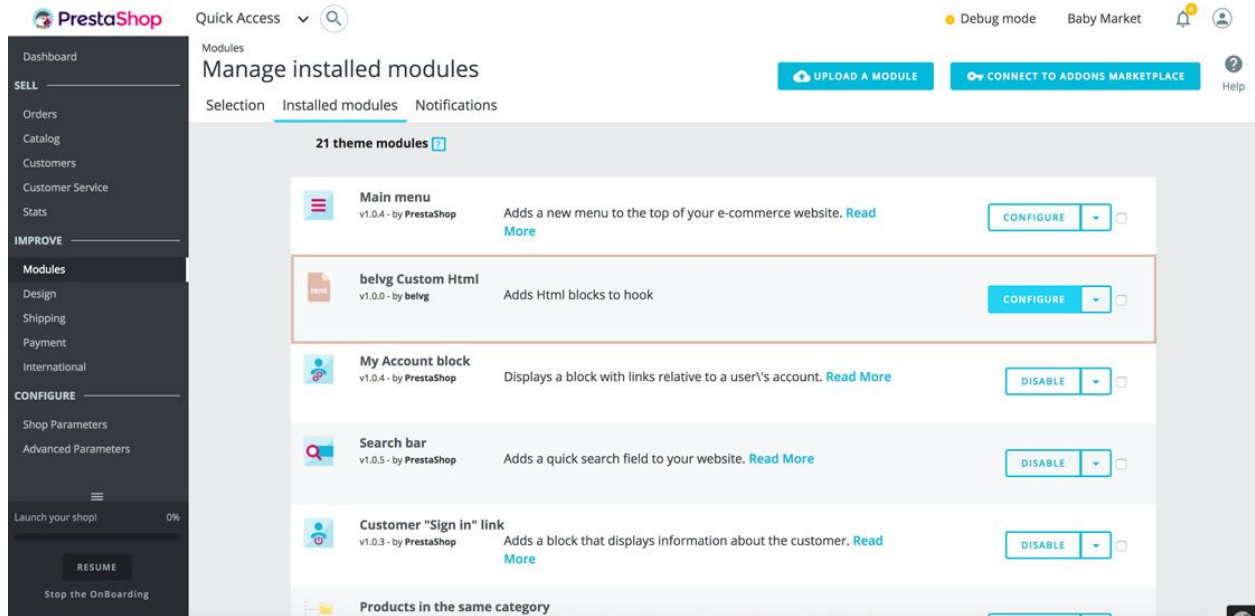
If you don't want to compile theme, and just want to add some minor changes use **assets/css** folder and **custom.css** file. The same for js: **assets/js custom.js** file.





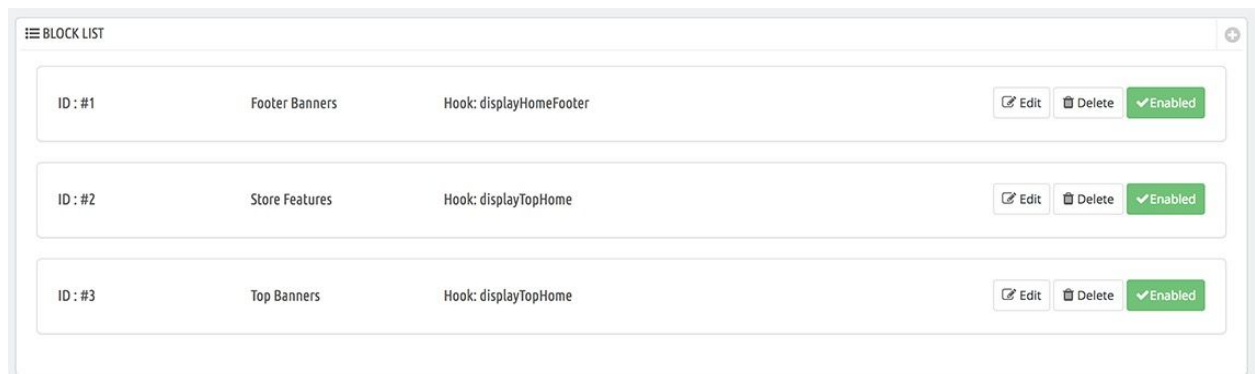
4. BeIVG Custom HTML


