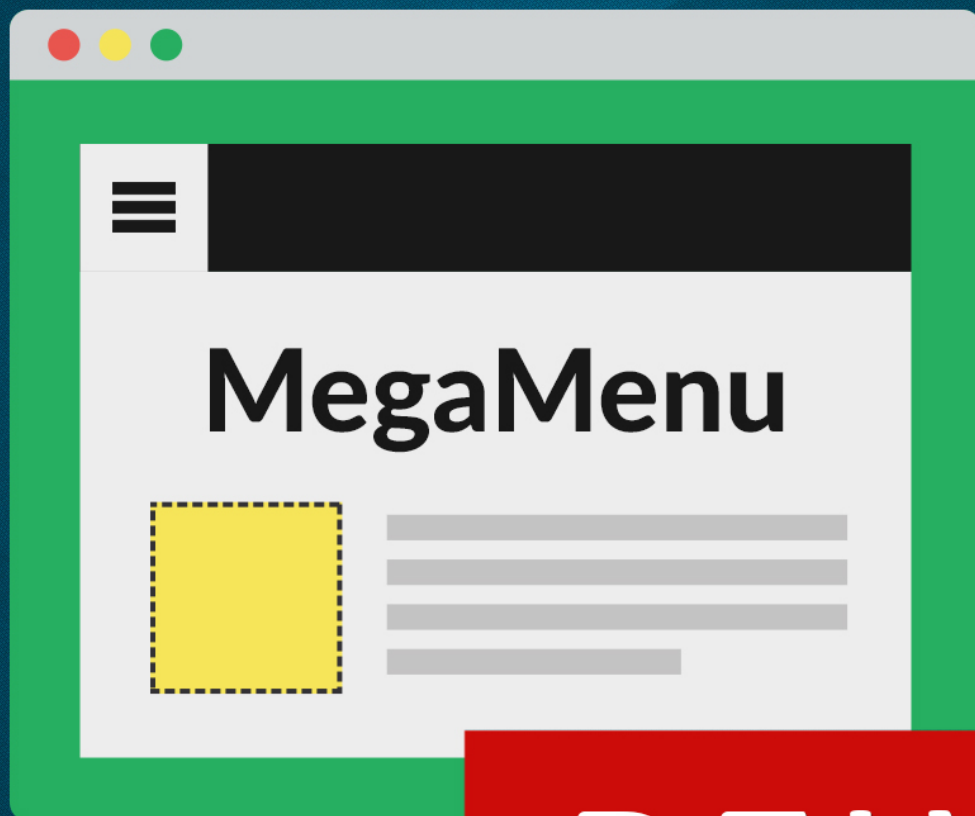

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1. Introduction to MegaMenu

The default Prestashop store menu has always been quite limited and allows displaying only shop categories and subcategories. But this is not always enough to provide real user-friendly, informative and intuitive navigation to let your customers quickly search and find necessary items and conveniently jump from section to section.

The **MegaMenu** module solves all the default Prestashop menu drawbacks and lets you create your own menu without any limitations!

Key features:

- Create unlimited number of menu categories and subcategories and arrange them in the way you like;
- Add to the menu any type of content: contacts, maps, social media, links, category info, texts or whatever you would like to display;
- Customize your own css styles to make the menu content look unique and attractive;
- Create menu content with the WYSIWYG editor;
- Customize the mobile version of the menu.

2. How to Install and Deactivate

How to Install

1. Set 777 or 0777 on the folders: **'/modules/'**

Important! Change all permissions back after installation.

2. Go to **Modules** -> **Add a module from my computer** -> choose the file (.zip) -> upload this module. Choose module in section **Front Office Features** and install it.

3. Go to **Advanced Parameters** -> **Performance** -> click the **Clear Smarty Cache** button

How to Deactivate

Click the button **Disable** in **Modules** -> **Front Office Features**.

To remove the extension from the server, press **Delete** in **Modules** -> **Front Office Features**.

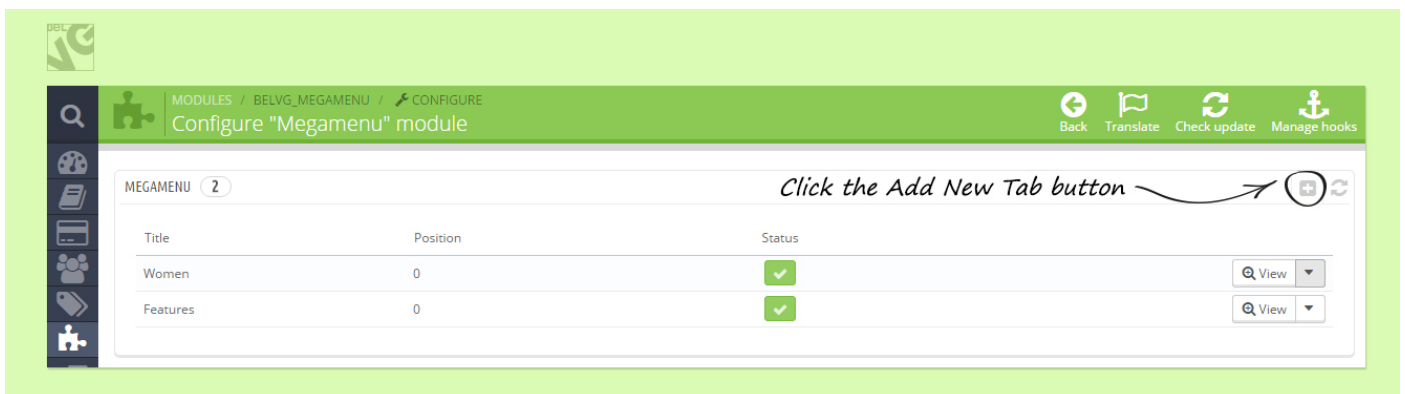
3. How to Configure

Let's see the module configuration settings. Log into your Prestashop admin panel and go to **Modules - Modules** - find the **MageMenu** module in the list and click **Configure**.

How to create menu categories

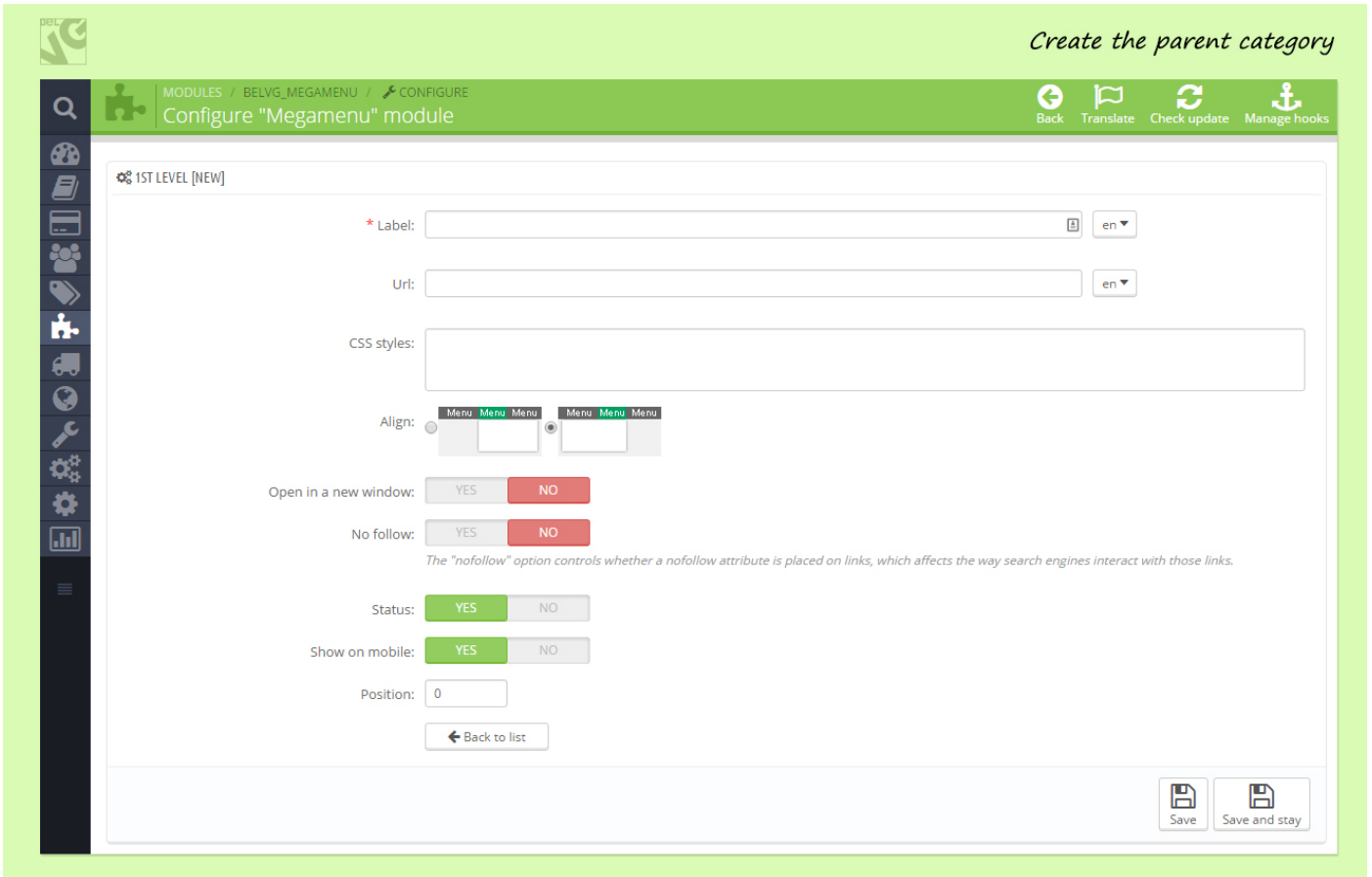
When you log into the main module settings window it displays the list of available parent categories.

To create your first parent category click the **Add New Tab** button



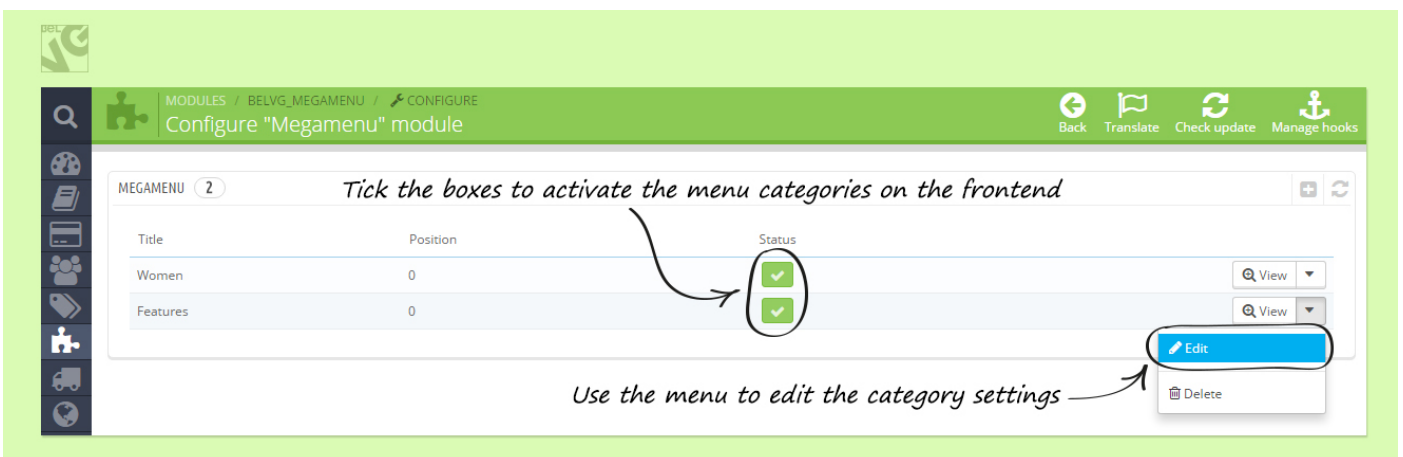
The module will open the editor to let you create the parent category. The editor will contain the following options to set up:

- **Label** - give name to the new category. The name will also be applied to the frontend;
- **URL** - set specific URL name for the category;
- **CSS Styles** - apply your own custom styles. If no custom styles are applied the module will use the default ones;
- **Align** - choose the position of the category on the page;
- **Open in a new window** - choose whether the menu category should open in a new window or the current page will be reloaded;
- **Nofollow** - specify the type of the links to be used in the menu category;
- **Status** – select the status of the category;
- **Show on mobile** - select Yes if you wish to display the same category on the mobile version of your store, otherwise it will not be visible on mobile devices;
- **Position** – specify the category position.



Once you are ready with the settings click **Yes** and your first parent menu category is ready.

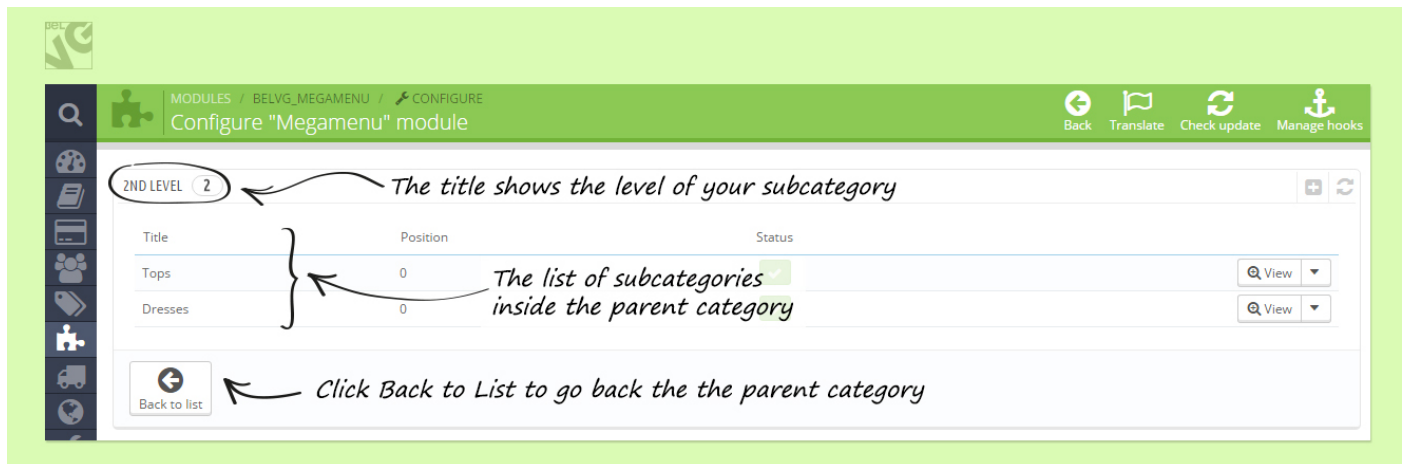
The module will display the list of available categories that you can add to your page menu on the frontend. Just enable the **Status** box against the category you wish to include on the frontend and the module will automatically add it to your store. To access the category settings use the dropdown menu button.



How to add subcategories

Once you create the list of categories you can go on and start filling them up with the 2nd and 3rd level subcategories and end pages.

Click the required parent category where you wish to add the 2nd level subcategories.



Click the **Add new Tab** button to add a new subcategory. The subcategory settings include the following options:

- **Parent** - select the parent directory where this new subcategory will be added;
- **URL** - set specific URL name for the subcategory;
- **CSS Styles** - apply your own custom styles. If no custom styles are applied the module will use the default ones;
- **IS** – choose whether to use arrow near the category name;
- **Open in a new window** - choose whether the menu subcategory will open in a new window or the current page will reload;
- **Nofollow** - specify the type of the links to be used in the subcategory;
- **Status** – select the status of the category;
- **Show on mobile** - select Yes if you wish to display the same menu subcategory on the mobile version of your store, otherwise it will not be visible on mobile devices;
- **Position** – specify the category position.

How to add end menu pages

When you are ready with the list of your parent categories and subcategories it is time to add the end-menu pages.

- Click the necessary 2-nd level subcategory to access the 3-rd level subcategory editor;
- Click **Add New** to create the end-menu page.

The module will load the 3-rd level subcategory editor that will contain the following settings:



- **Column count** - set the number of columns (from 1 to 4) that the end menu page will display. Each column may contain different type of content and information;
- **Show column on mobile** - choose Yes if you wish this column to be available on the mobile version of your store;
- **Column 1 editor** - use the WYSIWG editor to create the content of your column.

- **Open in a new window** - choose whether the menu subcategory will open in a new window or the current page will reload;
- **Nofollow** - specify the type of the links to be used in the subcategory;
- **Status** – select the status of the category;
- **Show on mobile** - select Yes if you wish to display the same menu subcategory on the mobile version of your store, otherwise it will not be visible on mobile devices;
- **Position** – specify the category position.


That is all! Your MegaMenu is now ready to work.

Once you activate your parent categories and subcategories the module will automatically add the new menu online onto your web-store.

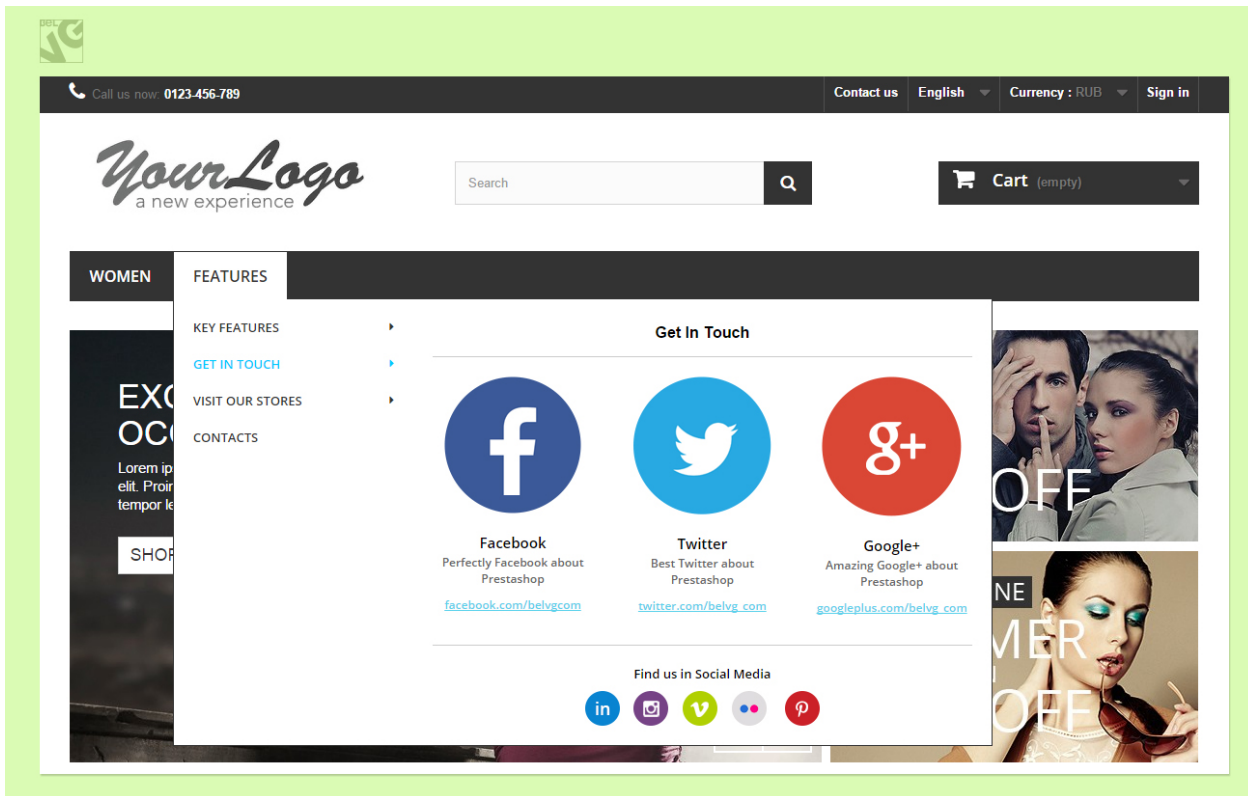
The new menu with 3 level subcategories is added to the store



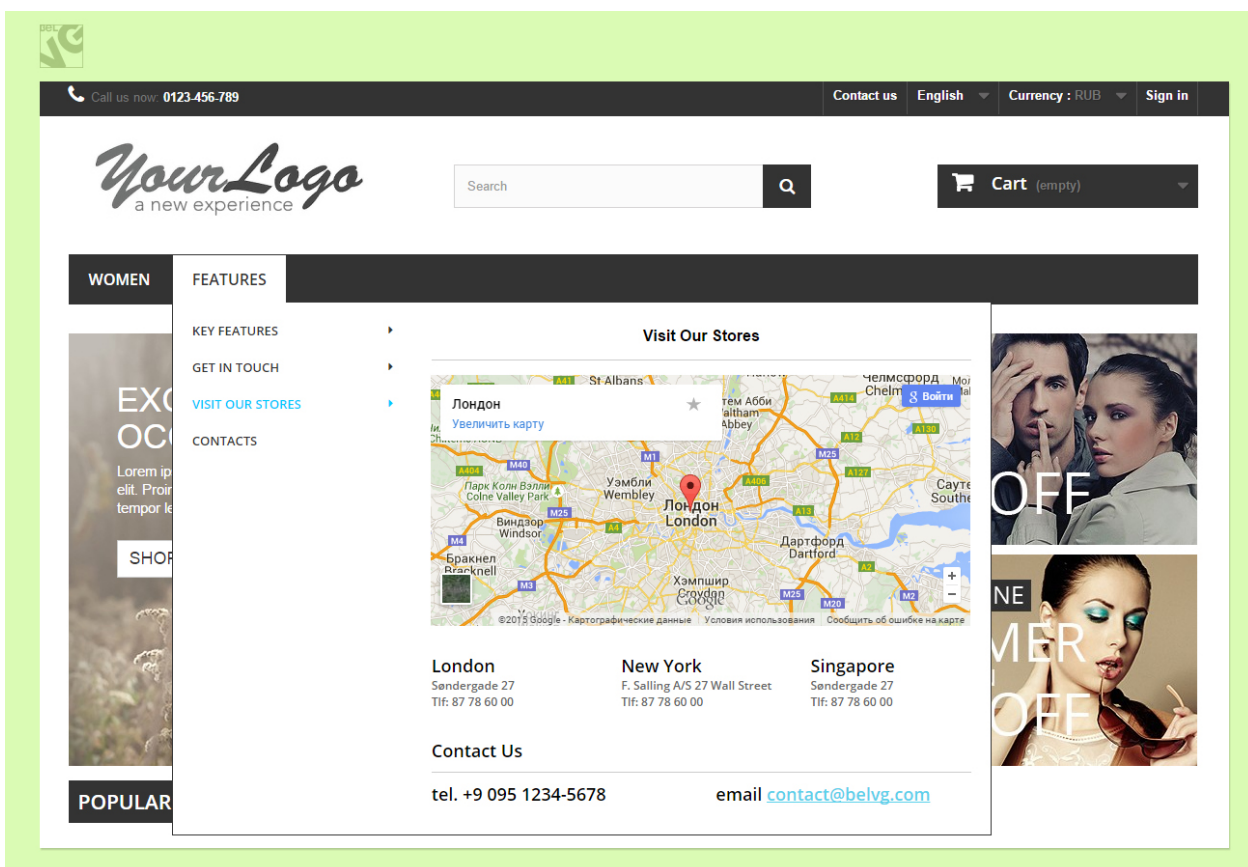

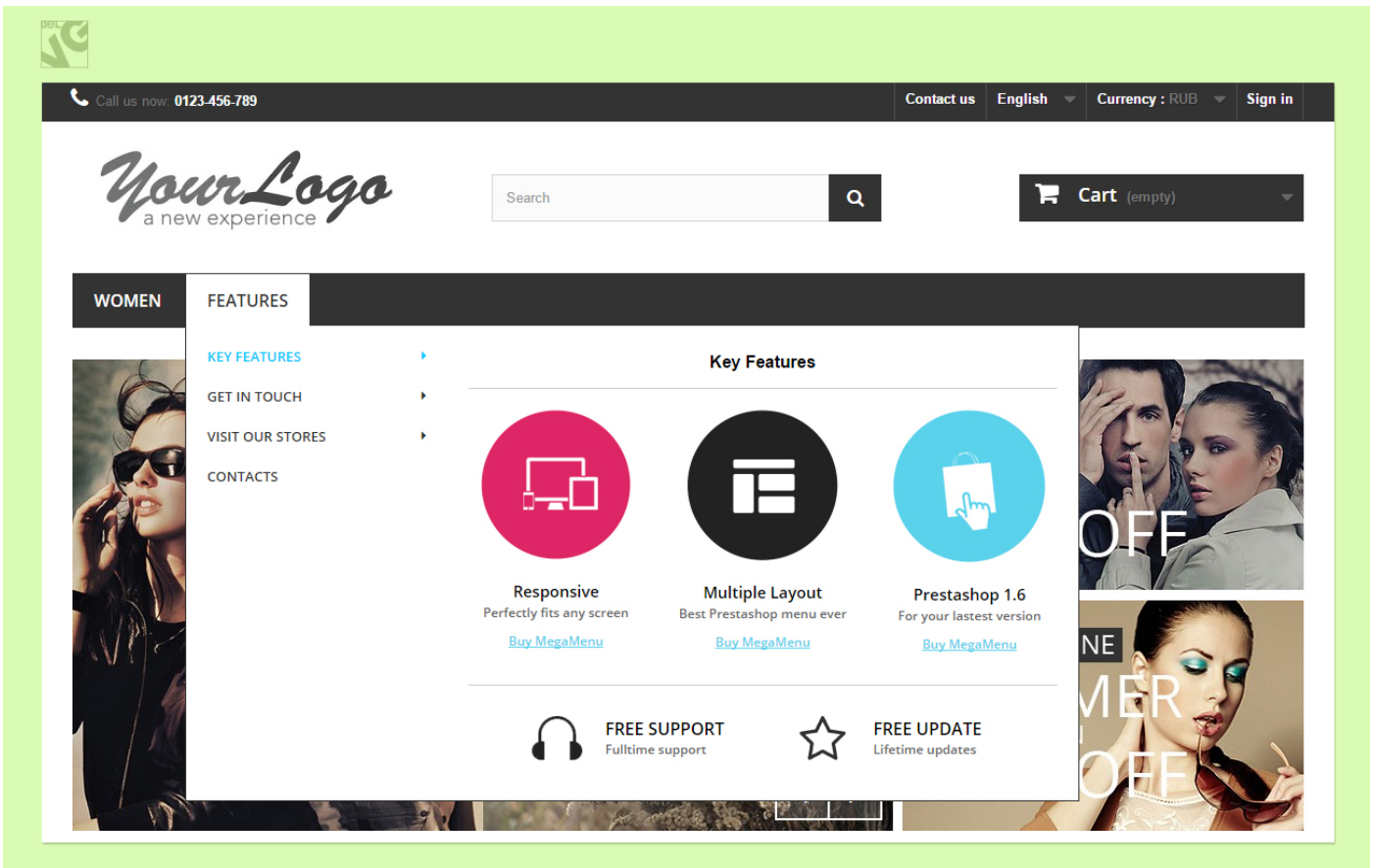
