1. Introduction to Store Locator

Perfect for retail network owners, Prestashop Store Locator module helps customers find the local store of yours on Google Maps and check if the required item is in stock there. User location can be configured to be detected automatically so that the list of the nearest shops could be displayed. In the product page, the information about stores with this item is available as well.

Key features:

- Store search by user location and products in stock.
- Automatic user location detection.
- Customizable searching radius.
- Hint text in the product search form.
- Closest stores names, addresses, and distances in search results.
- Possibility to upload a CSV file, where specified stores and available items.
- Displaying distance in kilometers/miles.
- Easy connection to Google Maps via API.

Overall information

Once you want clients to buy products in your offline stores, Prestashop Store Locator module will be a great solution.

The Google Maps based store locator is embedded right into your default *Our Stores* page. It locates all your shops to let users find the nearest one. Customers enter the item name in Search for products field and get the information about stores with this item in stock.

Map locations are being displayed in a user-friendly sliding manner. Store's data contains working hours, address, profile picture.



2. How to Install

- Go to Modules → Modules and Services, upload the module on the server using the Upload a Module button.
- 2. In the dropdown list choose **Product Page**, find **Store Locator** on the opened page, click **Install.**
- 3. Go to Advanced Parameters → Performance → Disable cache, click the Clear Smarty Cache button.
- Once you finish configuring the module go back to Advanced Parameters → Performance and enable cache back.

How to Deactivate

- 1. Go to Modules → Modules and Services.
- 2. Switch to the Installed Modules tab.
- Select the Store Locator module in the list, in dropdown list select the Uninstall option.
- Once the module is uninstalled go to Advanced Parameters → Performance, click the Clear Smarty Cache button.



3. How to Configure

Note: The Store Locator module has been developed and tested only on the default Prestashop theme, so the setting descriptions and screenshots provided in this manual may differ from those you may see if using some custom theme.

General Settings

To access module settings log into your admin dashboard and navigate to **Improve** \rightarrow **Modules** \rightarrow **Modules & Services**, switch to the **Installed Modules** tab. In the list of installed modules find **Store Locator** and click **Configure**.

Default module settings will offer the following options:

- Google Maps API Key: enter an API key of the Google Maps service. This API will be used by your store to detect the location of customers, draw the location of your stores on the map and provide directions to the nearest ones. To get an API key please visit the official <u>Google Maps APIs</u> section.
- Latitude/Longitude: enter the default coordinates that will be applied to the map if customers' location can not be detected.
- Image for the Store Locator: upload an image file that will be used to mark your stores on the map.
- **Distance Unit:** select to measure the distance either in miles or kilometers.



- Allow User Autolocation: if this option is enabled a customer will see a pop-up window asking to allow the store to auto-detect the location of the user. If the customer selects Allow the map will load current user's location, otherwise the default location that is specified in the Latitude/Longitude section will be applied.
- Show Stores Block on the Product Page: choose YES to show the list of stores and their addresses where the product is in stock. It's also available to open Google Maps and get directions to the store in the new tab / window.
- CSV Import: here you can upload a csv file with the list of stores and items that are available in stock for each of your stores. This way each product page will give exact information about the stores and the items they have in stock. Secondly, on the **Our Stores** page it will be possible to search for any item and get the list of stores and their address where this item is available.
- Delete All Before Import: if you add new records about available items to an existing CSV file, it is better to select YES to delete all previously imported files to avoid duplicates.

4. How to Use

Now let's see how the extension works on the frontend.

When a customer visits your website for the first time a pop-up appears asking the permission to detect the location of the user. If the permission is granted the map will load the user's current location, otherwise, the default coordinates will be displayed.





The search-bar above the map allows searching by product name — the module will mark all stores that have the specified product in stock within the selected radius.





Below the map it will list the exact addresses and indicate the distance from the current user's location.

Selecting a store will load a pop-up that provides the information about the open hours and the link to get directions to the store via Google Maps.





Each product page will have a new block added with the list the stores where that item is available.
